Players should:

- 1. make every effort to develop their own football abilities
- 2. give maximum effort and set a positive example to others
- 3. help and encourage their team members
- 4. listen to the Manager and Coach and act accordingly
- 5. understand and abide by the Laws of the Game and competition rules
- 6. show good sportsmanship and fair play
- 7. show respect for other players, referees, team officials, and supporters
- 8. never endanger other players with rough or violent play
- 9. accept the decision of the referees without protest
- 10. look after the facilities and equipment
